New Features

There's an updated, more sophisticated interface, including a new look and feel, and a new color scheme and graphics. The scoreboard has also been redesigned; the arcade-style point system rewards students according to their scores, providing them with beach-theme icons instead of their daily grade percentages.

Our new animated Flash Fuzzies encourage the students to do well, laugh, and basically have more fun during their self-paced tutorial experience. The former Warm Fuzzies have also been rejuvenated with new graphics and sounds.

Math

Grades 1-2 Math (all states): The primary math **Incredible Tutor™** titles have been revised, per teacher requests, so that they're easier for first and second graders enrolled in their first semesters. Specifically, the vocabulary used in the word problems was changed to make the items easier for beginning readers.

Science

Grades 3-5 Science (TAKS): Some changes have been made to the **Incredible Tutor™** 3-5 Science measurement problems. For example, the use of the on-screen ruler now reflects the TAKS instructions.

Grade 8 Science (TAKS): We're very happy to announce the release of our **Incredible Tutor™** Grade 8 TAKS Science title! This title includes 53 grade-appropriate lessons with 10 questions per lesson, or 530 questions total.

This title also includes 15 cluster items, 15 measurement items, and 15 gridded items. These items cover all the assessed TEKS and were created and reviewed by Texas middle school

teachers, professional science authors, and traditional textbook editors. The 8th grade content covers earth sciences, physics, chemistry, and life sciences, as well as numerous items covering laboratory tools, experiments, and safety precautions. The items ask students to read and interpret maps, identify laboratory tools, calculate using SI units, and much more.

Grades 9-11 Science (TAKS): We've updated the high school science gridded items so that they are presented in the same format as the TAKS test. They now indicate to how many decimals to carry the number.

On the Horizon

In May 2005, the Texas Education Agency released the modified math TEKS for grades 6-11 to the public. In October 2005, TEA released the modified math TEKS for grades 1-5. According to the Texas Education Agency timeline, field test items that incorporate the recent TEKS changes could appear on the TAKS math assessments as soon as spring 2007. (There are no current plans to create spring 2007 field test items for the tests in grades 1-5.) All teachers in Texas are encouraged to begin teaching the latest math TEKS in August 2006.

Our in-house math curriculum developers have been evaluating the math TEKS modifications and making sure these changes are reflected in our elementary, middle school, and high school math titles. An **Incredible Tutor™** update containing these changes will be available for your classroom by fall 2006.
